



Alert! Service Pack 34 Requires Windows® .NET 4.6

How to Update Your Server's Windows Operating System Versions 7, 8, 8.1, and 10

1. Click the **Start** button in the lower-left corner to Open Windows Update.
2. In the search box, type **Update** and then, in the list of results, click either **Windows Update** or **Check for updates**.
3. Click the **Check for updates** button and wait while Windows looks for the latest updates for your computer.
4. If you see a message that important updates are available or telling you to review important updates, click the message to view and select the important updates to download or install.
5. In the list, click the important updates for more information. Select the checkboxes for any updates you want to install, and then click **OK**.
6. Click **Install updates**.



Other Notes:

- We recommend you make a full server backup prior to installing Windows updates.
- Older versions of .NET will receive a QAU error, if you try to install SP 34.
- The .NET 4.6 version requirement applies only to your server, not to workstations.

If you are using Windows 7 for your application server, we recommend that you upgrade hardware. Windows stopped support for this version in January 2020.
